In that sense, this chart takes into consideration the world music (including traditional) that comes from the Balkan countries, also the world music works of the Balkan-born musicians living outside of this region, as well as the music and artists from all around the world that have connections to the Balkan sound.

Balkan Chart was established under the umbrella of World Music association of Serbia and is curated by the editor-in-chief of WMAS's portal and Magazine Etnoumlje, Marija Vitas.

The lists will be published quarterly (end of March/June/September/December).
